

How to add a resource?

Resources For Soil Advisors Interactive Map

To add a new entry, click on the "Add A Resource" button on the bottom right corner of the map and fill in all the required information.

- **Name the resource:** Enter the title of the webpage, the name of the training programme, or the name of the tool.
- **Provider:** Indicate the organisation that developed the resource, the name of the author/director (for documents or personal pages), or the group name (for peer networks).
- **Description:** Provide a brief description of the resource (max. 500 characters).
- **Categories:** Select the appropriate options for resource type, format (onsite/online/hybrid), and access cost.
- Location: Enter the address or coordinates where the resource should appear on the map. If you prefer to place the pin manually, type the name of a nearby location (city or municipality) and adjust the pin as needed. For resources with multiple locations or no physical address, place the pin anywhere within a relevant country.
- Language: List all languages in which the resource is available.
- Webpage: Provide the URL to the resource (in full format, e.g. http://...).
- E-mail address (optional): If you wish to provide a contact email, enter it here. This email will be visible to all visitors of the map.
